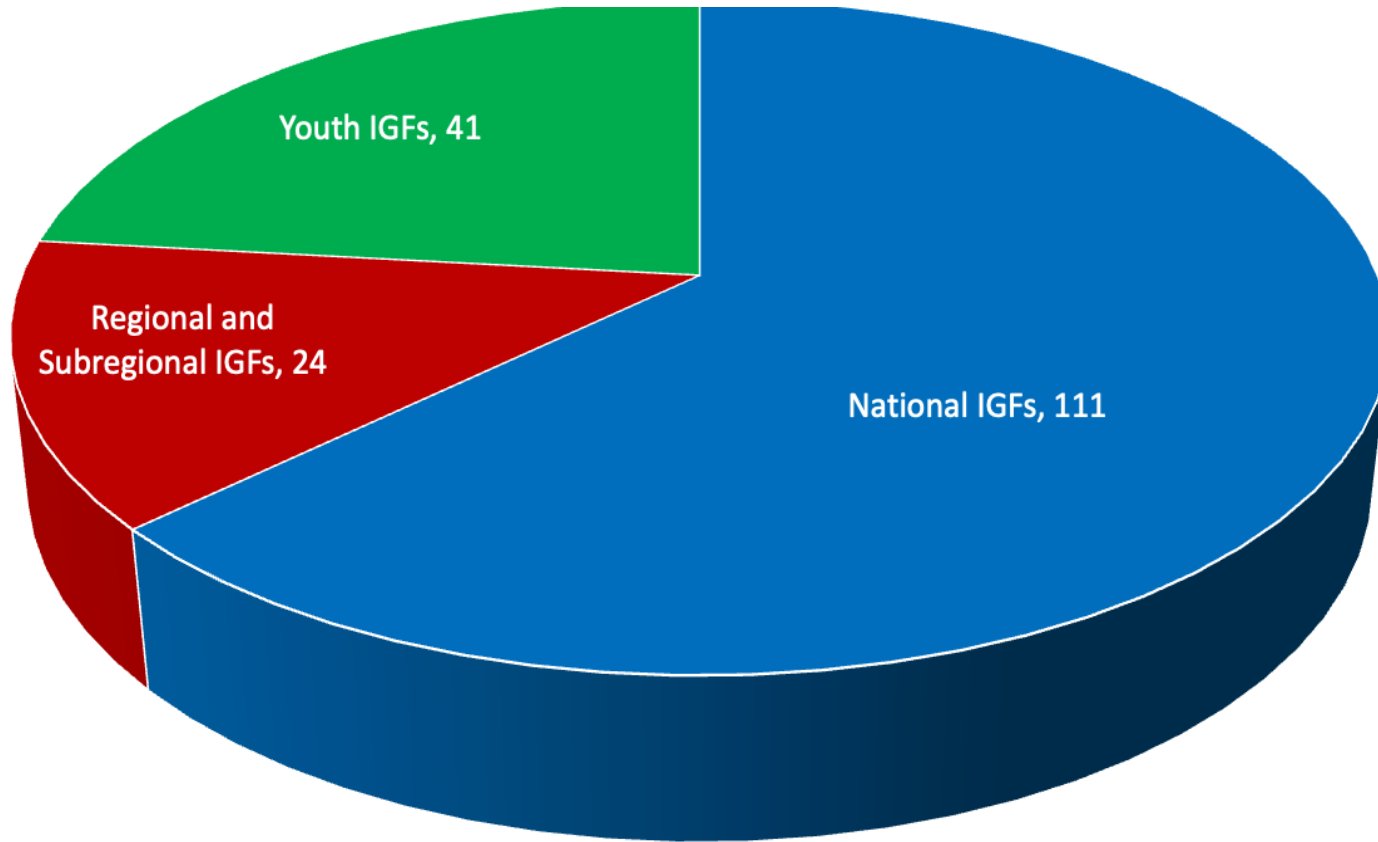

NRIs Current Record (176)



- National IGFs exist on five different continents in five different UN regional groups:
 - Africa (35)
 - Asia Pacific (19)
 - Eastern Europe (17)
 - GRULAC (21)
 - WEOG (18)
- A number of national and regional IGFs have integrated youth-focused programmes.

IGF 2025 Youth Track – theme and issues

- IGF 2025 Youth Track's overall focus is on **multistakeholder approach to governing of the Internet and role of youth**.
- **Structure:** 4 capacity development workshops at regional IGFs + IGF 2025 Global Youth Summit on 23 June in Lillestrøm + database of youth experts to be shared with the IGF session organizers for their (communities) further engagement
- **Youth IGF coordinators** coordinate their **communities'** inputs to help understand what could be a concrete commitment-oriented issue-focus of each of the sessions. Much attention has attracted the age verification and social media regulation. The first round of open consultations prioritized these themes:
 - *Cybersecurity & trust*
 - *Media & content*
 - *Digital cooperation & multistakeholder approach*
 - *Environmental sustainability & climate change*
 - *Emerging tech & innovation*
- **Nature of all sessions: dialogue** between **youth and senior stakeholders**. Cooperation with the parliamentary track continues.
- **Modus operandi:** IGF Youth Mailing List + Regular monthly meetings + Newsletter updates + Webinars

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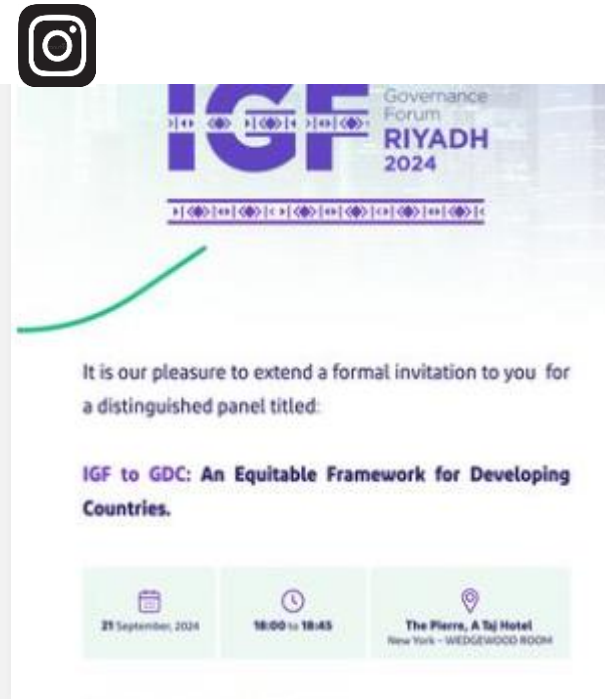
